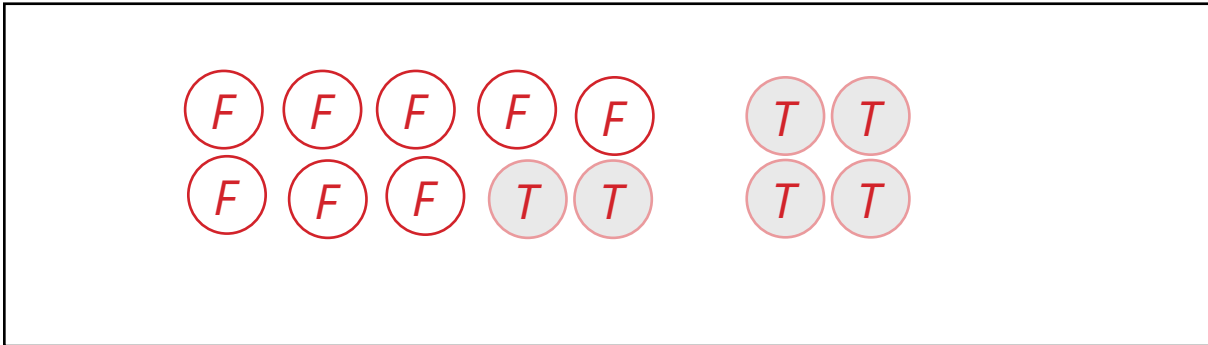

ANSWER KEY

8. Rosa has 14 toy animals. She has some turtles and 8 frogs. Can she have the same number of turtles as frogs? Use a model to show your answer.

My Model: *Sample model showing the frogs and turtles adding up to 14.*



My Answer:

*No. Rosa has 6 turtles and 8 frogs.*

9. Use the numbers 6, 9, and 15.  
 \* Write 2 addition number sentences using all three numbers.  
 \* Write 2 subtraction number sentences using all three numbers.

$$6 + 9 = 15$$

$$15 - 9 = 6$$

$$9 + 6 = 15$$

$$15 - 6 = 9$$
