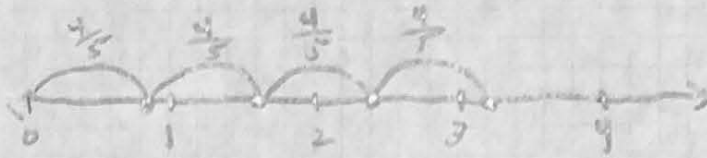


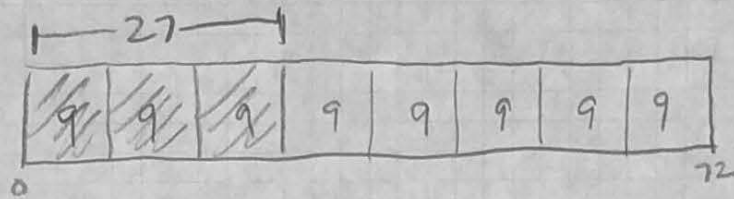
Stage 23: Multiplying Fractions and Wholes

Example 1:



$$4 \times \frac{4}{5} = 3 \frac{1}{5} \text{ or } \frac{16}{5}$$

Example 2:

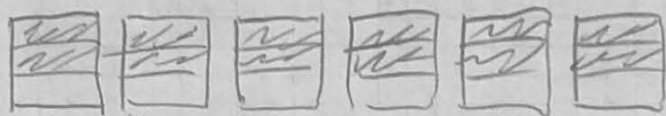


$$\frac{3}{8} \times 72 = 27$$

MY OWN:

Michael rides his bike every day after school for 6 days. During each ride, Michael drinks $\frac{2}{3}$ liters of water.

How many liters of water does he drink in all?



$$6 \times \frac{2}{3} = \frac{12}{3}$$

He drinks $\frac{12}{3}$ liters, or 4 liters
